	After discussion no objection was made to this application.	
<b>4/240417</b>	<b>Urgent matters to be brought to the attention of the Parish Council</b>	
	It was agreed the next Agenda would include an item considering whether the Parish Council should make a contribution to the cost of the new footpath at the Community Centre car park, installed for the benefit of school-run drivers using the car park as requested.  It was agreed the Parish Council would seek support from the police for proper observation of the Respect Zone outside the school, which is again being ignored by some drivers to the detriment of road safety.
