The Henley Players have enjoyed some great productions this year with ever increasing members & audiences.

No sooner had we finished Aladdin in Jan 2014 then we were preparing, auditioning & rehearsing our January 2015 production of Jack & the Beanstalk.

This was by far the biggest cast & production we have put on the now famous Henley stage! The junior chorus was 15 on its own! Plus the normal cast made it 26 members & all of them needed a minimum of 2 costumes to make!

The set was very impressive and best by far. Because of the number of scenes we had to hire in 2 professional backdrop curtains and even the Beanstalk was an inflatable hired from the Norwich theatre! We had an audience capacity of 98% over 3 performances that's 5 empty seats out of 432.

Feedback was once again very positive – The band was as normal very professional and the cast really enjoyed their experience. With the increased numbers of young talent the players decided to give them an opportunity to perform in their own musical production of Bugsy Malone in early May 2015.

The committee only had a 12 week lead time from audition to first performance. The young cast really worked hard during rehearsals and we are pleased to say that Saturday was a success. This was in the end a major production with many scenes & props - Including a seven piece school band.

Work is now underway with our next pantomime - Snow White & the Seven Dwarfs. The script is being written by a local author who knows Henley & its famous residents very well! So it will have a local touch and some interesting phases!
